Winchester Mayfest 2017

On Saturday 20th May 2017, the streets of Winchester will once again come alive with the sights and sounds of dancing and music, as the Mayfest comes to town. After the success of the 2016 event, we are hoping for an even bigger and better show, with equally fantastic weather!

At this stage, many details are yet to be finalised; however, we anticipate between 25 and 40 dance sides taking part in locations across the City Centre, this year to include indoor venues such as the famous Great Hall, and the Brooks Shopping Centre. The Cathedral West Front will be used until 1pm, and the central locations such as the Buttercross, High Street and Museum Square will host day-long dancing. Once again, the covered area known as St Maurice's Covert will be used for Appalachian dancing and choral performances, while the beautiful little St Lawrence's Church welcomes the Southampton Folk Orchestra, Bella Voce youth choir and Barton Stacey choir.

Dance sides are visiting from a 30-mile radius or further, so spectators will have the pleasure of seeing sides who don't normally attend the southern festivals. All styles of folk dancing will be represented: we anticipate Cotswold and Border Morris, North West clog, Southern Step, Stave dancing, Rapper and Appalachian, to name a few!

As well as ongoing performances throughout the day, most sides will take part in the Mayor's Show, a 90-minute spectacle performed for the Mayor, with each side performing one show

dance. This will be followed by a mass audience participation dance led by Wickham Morris (to be finalised).

For those wishing to participate as well as spectate, there will be maypole and southern step workshops and displays running in the Cathedral Outer Close for adults and children (details to be finalised). For younger members, there will be children's entertainment, which may consist of circus skills, storytelling or Punch & Judy (again, to be finalised!)

And for those who still have energy to spare at the end of the day, SHOCC has organised a ceilidh at Winchester Guildhall, featuring the exciting and popular band Threepenny Bit, with Lisa Purkiss as the caller. For details and ticket sales, please visit the SHOCC website: www.shocc.co.uk. This will be preceded by a music session also in the Guildhall.

On the subject of music sessions, this year our Mayfest has been deliberately planned to coincide with the Winchester pubs Mayfest, where various local alehouses will be running music events of their own; in particular The Eclipse Inn will have live music from 1pm (www.eclipseinnwinchester.co.uk) and for those who would like to make a weekend of it, the newly refurbished Westgate pub is offering rooms at discounted rates, meals all day, and hopefully an evening and late night music session (open group). www.westgatewinchester.com

She and her husband Michael chanced upon Country Dancing in the sixties when they lived in London. Monica worked with Marjorie Fennessy - now an important figure in the history of EFDSS. Through her they learned about Cecil Sharp House and began going to dances there.

When they moved to Winchester they found a Folk Dance Club in Sparshalt and were also regulars at Eastleigh FDC, especially after Sparshalt closed down. When Michael died, Monica continued dancing at Eastleigh and also joined Mainly Playford in Bishop's Waltham. She went to the Soberton workshops during the winter months and enjoyed both the Isle of Wight Folk Dance Holidays and John Turner's Dancing Holidays in Bournemouth in the summer.

Her dancing days were ended mainly by difficulties with her ankles, but fairly recently she was delighted to attend the EFDSS Centenary Gathering at Cecil Sharp House with Ken Coates. As they drove through London, she recognised all her old haunts and animatedly pointed out the places her husband had helped to design in his work as an architect in Camden. She enjoyed the day enormously and was a delightful companion. Ken is very pleased to be able to remember her from that day as well as from the many dances they shared.
