## FASH Chat – ‘Private Henry Tandey VC’

The 7th of this month sees the first performance of ‘Private Henry Tandey VC’; keeping the traditions of folk music in Hampshire alive, this show is the culmination of an exciting project and will tour the South during October and November.

It is a ‘Stage Play meets Folk Opera’, i.e. a story told by both actors and musicians. Henry Tandey was the most decorated British Soldier of World War 1. A humble British Private, having been awarded the Victoria Cross, the Distinguished Conduct Medal (DCM), the Military Medal (MM) and several others, and having been mentioned in despatches on five occasions, Henry is remembered for something he didn’t do rather than something he did. His place in history is tarnished by an incident that happened on the 28th September 1918; on that day he had an injured German soldier in his gun sights but because of his sense of humanity and fair play he didn’t pull the trigger. That young German infantryman turned out to be none other than Adolf Hitler! Henry, therefore, played an unwelcome part in the course of world history.

His story is told in both words and music, and stars local men Ben Bracken as Henry Tandey VC and John Rowlinson as Brigadier Sir John Smyth VC. Mike Grogan has written the show, with Mike and Robert Martin, a fiddle player from Farlington, providing the music through voice, violin, guitar, tenor guitar and banjolele.

You may have already heard some of the songs from the show, as Mike has sung several

when he has visited folk clubs in the area. It is very much a Hampshire production, and many of the tour dates are located within our county.

The first performance takes place in Soberton, at the Village Hall, on the 7th October, and tickets are available via [www.ticketsource.co.uk/date/388349](http://www.ticketsource.co.uk/date/388349) or by calling 01329 834176. The show moves to The Theatre, Chipping Norton for the 15th, before returning to Hampshire at The Groundlings Theatre (Kent Street) in Portsmouth on the 20th. On the 26th another trip out of county to The Capitol in Horsham is followed by performances at The Forest Arts Centre on the 27th and Hanger Farm on the 28th. The 3rd November has the show at The Ashcroft Arts Centre in Fareham, before it goes out of county again to Haslemere Hall the next day. The Spring Arts and Heritage Centre hosts the show on the 7th November, and on the 9th it plays at Queen Mary College, Basingstoke. Tickets for the Basingstoke show are available via [www.qmc.ac.uk](http://www.qmc.ac.uk) or 01256 417500. The final two performances are in Warminster and Shaftsbury.

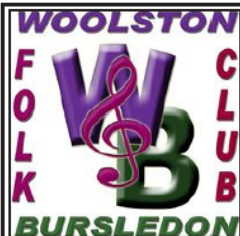
