## FASH Chat 1 – Angels Without Wings

FASH loves to celebrate local Hampshire events and achievements and one such is the writing of a new folk song. Heidi Talbot, John McCusker and Boo Hewerdine are major names as folk artists and when they performed at Forest Folk back in 2011, Boo wrote Angels Without Wings for Heidi in our famous ‘green room’. It is a lovely song and always nice to know some of the history behind its evolution, especially when it is local.

Now Heidi Talbot & John McCusker are touring as a duo to celebrate their tenth year as musical partners with the new mini-album, ‘Love Is The Bridge Between Two Hearts’, released on 20th April on Under One Sky Records. This is the first time the husband and wife duo have collaborated exclusively as a duo.

John McCusker has long been renowned for his sonic adventures, which has earned him many coveted awards over his 27-year music career. John was awarded the coveted BBC Radio 2 Musician of the Year in 2003 and also The Spirit of Scotland Award for music in 1999 and again in 2009. 2016 saw John presented with the Good Tradition Award and perform with his band at the BBC Radio 2 Folk Awards at The Royal Albert Hall.

Known for her beautiful voice, sweet melodies and intricate arrangements, Heidi Talbot first came to prominence as a member of Irish-American female group Cherish the Ladies,

before embarking on a successful solo career.

Working and recording together on ‘Love Is The Bridge Between Two Hearts’ has been an organic process, says John: “We’ve never had a big musical plan and we try and do what feels natural to us. Recording an album together seemed completely natural and we’re always striving to keep things as fresh as we can musically. As much for ourselves, as for the audience.”

‘Love Is The Bridge Between Two Hearts’ is the culmination of John and Heidi’s shared experiences and a love-letter to the traditional songs that inspired them both while growing up. John says, “The title ‘Love Is The Bridge Between Two Hearts’ was inspired by the new Queensferry Bridge in Scotland that we go past every day and that got us thinking about how many bridges we cross every day on tour. We loved the idea of bridges bringing people together. Looking at this beautiful new bridge, you start thinking about the traffic going each way and compare it to the music we’re putting across with this mini-album.”

Forest Folk say they are really looking forward to welcoming Heidi and John back to Forest Folk. John has been several times more recently with the brilliant Mike McGoldrick and John Doyle. They will be at Forest Folk on Monday 16th July, and no doubt they will be pressed to sing ‘Angels Without Wings’ along with their new tracks from the CD.

## FASH Chat 2 – Our Autumn/Winter Workshops

Our next season of workshops includes old and new favourites in the way of callers and dance styles and another of our Do Something Different days. Some more detail about the workshops for the first half of the season follow and the December/January issue of Solent Waves will cover the second half.

### **14 October 2018 at Twyford. Lisa Purkiss & ‘Dances Old and New’ with Andrew Purkiss**

Lisa was brought up in a family of folk music and dance, and thoroughly enjoys choreographing dances, from English clog and Appalachian stepping to ceilidh/country dances that can be easy or challenging. Her repertoire of dances includes original dances as well as ‘old favourites’, and she adjusts them according to the dancers she is working with. Lisa will be accompanied by Andrew Purkiss on accordion and they will use tunes that complement the dances.

### **4th November 2018 at Soberton John Turner & ‘From Playford to Shaw’ with Andrew Purkiss**

John Playford was a music publisher who first published books of dances in London in 1651. They were an aide-memoire for aspiring members of the upper classes. His first collection contained 104 dances and music. The range & complexity of these dances is quite astonishing and suggests a maturing development of country dance over many years prior to the publication. The style, we now call ‘Playford’, was popular in the western world for at least 150 years. In the early years of the 20th century, research by Cecil Sharp and his associates led to a revival in the UK’s Folk Music, Song & Dance traditions and the discovery of a vast wealth of material. Patrick Noel Shuldham-Shaw was born & raised

in a family deeply involved in this revival. Pat is revered in many parts of the Western World for his major contribution to this process. He was a choreographer, composer, arranger, researcher & collector, musician, singer, etc, etc. John will explore some samples of Playford dance as well as some of Pat’s choreographic contributions before his death in 1975.

### **9th December 2018 at Twyford ‘Getting Rhythmic with Folk Active’ – A Do Something Different Day!**

A chance to explore and enjoy the rhythms that underpin English folk tunes and dances. We’ll begin together with hand drumming led by percussionist Tom Gregory, before developing rhythmic skills on a range of traditional folk percussion instruments. Try jig dolls, spoons, bones and of course feet, with some local stepping led by Jo Harmer. Cath Watkins will co-ordinate the melodic side of the day; bring instruments if you want to play tunes as well.

### **20th January 2019 at Twyford Mike Courthold & ‘Something Borrowed’ with Andrew Purkiss**

New England Squares and Contras with figures borrowed from Modern Western Square Dancing. Mike has been an avid collector of American Squares and Contras from the New England, Mid-West, Southern, and Western States, plus quite a few written by UK callers. This workshop will concentrate on the Squares and Contras featuring figures that have been “borrowed” from Modern Western Square Dancing (such as Do Paso, Zoom, Pass the Ocean, Spin the Top, Box Circulate, etc.)

We’re quite excited about this new season and we’re sure that the workshops will be fun and informative, so don’t miss out - make sure you get the dates in your diary!
