FASH Chat – ‘The Future of Forest Tracks and the Hampshire Voices Website’

During the early 1970s a group of folk music enthusiasts in Southampton set up Forest Tracks as a Not For Profit Company with the aim of recording and publishing vinyl records of local folk singers and musicians, initially those who performed at the Fo’c’sle Folk Club. As time passed new technologies and broader recording policies were developed resulting in the publication of some 14 vinyl LPs and singles, 11 cassette tapes, including some field recording of Hampshire village singers and musicians, and 28 CDs including the re-issue of much of the early catalogue which had become unavailable in its original form.

With the passage of time, personnel has changed. Two members of the original team moved away from Southampton and two have died. Paul Marsh and I joined forces to relaunch the label at the turn of the century. Paul set up a website which he expanded over the years to include Hampshire Voices which highlighted Hampshire Songs and the work of George Gardiner. Paul was the driving force and technical expert and his sudden and totally unexpected death on 23 April 2018 has resulted in the company virtually grinding to a halt.

For the immediate future, I have secured the domain name and web host, and I aim to meet any orders whilst stocks last but, sadly, I do not have the energy or technical know-how to take

things forward. I would be very disappointed to see Forest Tracks disappear, but to move things forward would require a nucleus of people who care about Hampshire songs, music, dance and customs, and who have access to IT skills to develop the website. Paul had intended to run down the sales side of the business and transfer the complete catalogue of recordings to MP3 and upload it to the web pages and this could be the first stage of development. The Sussex Traditions website which has made available the various collections made in Sussex seems a good model to emulate. This site concentrates on “traditional” material but I would like to think that Forest Tracks could be developed to include information about both traditional collections and information about current folk activities in Hampshire to encourage more people to come and experience them.

The first step would be to establish a group of people with the interest and skills to take things forward. I would like to convene an initial meeting at which the approach to the way forward might be agreed but it can only happen if more people come forward. It would be a great pity if Forest Tracks fades away because it is taken for granted. Where am I ?

You might well ask? Well the answer is the Purbeck Dance Weekend in September. What a weekend it was! Situated in a picturesque part of Dorset at The D'Urberville Hall in Wool, we were set for a fine dancing extravaganza. The Friday evening dance got off to a flying start with Francis Oates and Rosemary Hunt calling to the music of Orion's ring. A warm-up with some favourites such as "After Dinner Maggot", "Little Brown Envelope" and "I Care not for these Gentlemen".

Saturday began with Francis Richardson, a caller of many years' experience. She enjoys a variety of styles and although Playford is her first and enduring love, she includes American and

Scottish in her repertoire. We were taken through such dances as "Impertinence" by Fried de Metz Herman, "Eastbourne Frolics" by Hilary Herbert and "Memorial Day" by Gary Roodman. Her second workshop included such dances as "The Brick Makers", "A Trip to Castle Howard", "A Cambridge Waltz" and "Beauty in Tears". Instructions were given clearly and with a light touch to detail.

Joe Hodgson followed on with a selection of dances in and around the Ralph Page era and the singing calls of the 40's and 50's. He is best known for calling and teaching New England squares and contras and we began with "Elegance and Simplicity". Joe emphasised the need to give courtesy turns, to complete the heys and get to the right place at the right time! His second workshop of the day was entitled "Why not Whynot?" and was based on two dance books written by Roger Whynot. These dances were challenging and such fun to do! The title of this article "Where am I?" is from one of the dances and might at times have been an appropriate question; nevertheless, Joe led us through each manoeuvre with great humour.

Sunday began with a workshop called "Squarish" with Joe. We were kept on our toes for dances such as "Fiddle Faddle" and "The Auctioneer", and "All Four Star" by Colin Hume. After a small break we moved on to Francis and her "Making Heys" workshop. A great selection of dances with, yes you guessed it, a variety of heys! A mixed workshop with both callers ended the sessions and we finished the weekend with a tea dance.

Lots of dancing in a great setting with superb calling and truly inspiring music; Orion's Ring and Stradivarius played for alternate workshops, joining as a 'massed band' for the Saturday evening and tea dances. So, perhaps the question at the beginning of this article should be "Where were you?" Come along next year and take part, make some new friends and most of all, enjoy dancing with like-minded people. Eastbourne
