FASH Chat – ‘Solent Waves’

Do you enjoy reading ‘Solent Waves’? Do you like getting it each month? Is the information on the various gigs and events useful? Is the opportunity to advertise your event cheaply worthwhile?

If the answer to any of these questions is a definite, or even a mild Yes, then let me tell you of the huge voluntary effort that goes into its production and distribution. FASH have been publishing this newsletter for over 40 years now, month after month. And month after month Dave Sutton, our editor, drags together information that people have sent him, pores through websites to find what is happening and then pulls together the magazine and our website www.fash.org.uk on which he maintains six months of future club dates. Getting information from the dance clubs is usually easy enough as the various secretaries mostly send him emails. The folk clubs are more varied and harder, but the Morris sides are almost always a nightmare of out-of-date information. Somehow it all gets written by the deadline of the 10th of the month.

Then it goes to Sarsen Press in Winchester who print it cheaply for us. It is in blue and white for some reason lost in the mists of time, but we carry on using this colour so it is recognisable. Then 600 or more sheets of each page are picked up by Terry Russell and he counts them out into piles and drives to four people to dump the pages on them. He does this labour month after month, always with a smile.

The key distribution person is Lyn Sutton and she receives a couple of hundred copies, labours

away folding the sheets and collating them, then prints out labels, packages them up and takes them for posting. This last bit sounds simple, but actually fighting the post office, who seem to have their very own wonderful ways, is not that easy.

She also keeps track of those lovely people who either pay for the postage or give donations of various amounts. Thank you, if you are one of these people and treat this as a gentle nudge if you are getting the newsletter for free. FASH supports the whole process financially, but it helps greatly if postage costs can be covered.

To reduce postage costs, John Turner, Paul Northcott, Lyn and I get piles of copies to fold and collate and then deliver them to people in their local areas. Further ‘links in the chain’, such as Penny Munday, then take the copies they have been given and carry them into places like the Spring Arts Centre in Havant. All this distribution is achieved in the couple of weeks after the editing process. We all try hard to get them out before the beginning of the month and usually succeed. A large number of people receive copies through e-mail, which Dave manages each month, and others read the magazine on-line because it is also posted to the FASH website.

So why have I written all this? To say thank you to our editor and distribution team, to everyone who sends in articles or information and to all the club secretaries who pass on the copies to club members. We hope it is all worthwhile and can carry on for another 40 years or so.

Welcome back to ‘Solent Waves’. The diaries are almost back to their normal lengths, although there are a few clubs which have still not published their September diaries so could not be included.

The moving of Mark Chadwick's concert in October from The Talking Heads to The 1865 alerted me to the fact that Folk concerts tend more to be at The 1865 now. Talking Heads appears still to be the place to go for sessions such as the weekly Irish session, the English Tunes session, as well as the Maple Leaf Lounge session and Ukulele Jam Rehearsal (many of which are free entry). Which venue appears in future diaries will depend on what is actually on.

After a long restoration, the Chapel in the Royal Victoria Country Park is once again available for hire. With its reputation for excellent acoustics, it will be interesting to see whether Chapel Sessions Music returns there; at the moment all their planned concerts still appear to be at St Edward's Church, Netley. The easiest way to see what is on seems to be via the Eventbrite website, www.eventbrite.co.uk, then 'browse' the events in this area. Sarah McQuaid will be appearing there on the 14th November.

An early notice for the fourth in the concert series in aid of The MacMillan Cancer Support charity: this year it is on the 9th November, at 7.30, and as usual it takes place at the Fishbourne Centre, Blackboy Lane, PO18 0DE. For tickets, at £15, drop an e-mail to sally.e.argent@gmail.com. Guests appearing include Phil Green & Jane Grover, Tom Perry & Clive Brooks, Lynne Heraud & Pat Turner and Pete Morton. As a further incentive, there will be the usual huge raffle with many great prizes.

Notice of another charity concert came to us via Focsle Music: Rob Noble and the Shantyhounds have organised a concert featuring themselves and the Barnet Hill Lifeboat Crew, together with songs from individual members of these groups. It takes place on 27th October at 2.00 pm at St Stephen's Church, Church Road, Shottermill, Haslemere GU27 1NS – right on the edge of our county – and is in aid of a children's home in Kenya which Rob has supported for over 20 years. have arranged another Day of Dance this year, on the 15th September. With display dancing at four locations in the middle of Southampton (all within easy walking distance of each other), from 11.00 until 4.00, the day finishes with a ceilidh at St Barnabas Church Hall, Lodge Road, SO14 6TE. Local band Jigfoot will be providing the music for the ceilidh and tickets at £10 are available by e-mailing folkdancesouthampton@gmail.com. For lots more information, guidance on how to get there, parking etc. see the website <http://folkdancesouthampton.weebly.com>. This is an event that FASH is supporting.

If you have already glanced at the back page of this issue, you may have noticed that the posts of a couple of our committee members have changed. Lin Rayner and Dennis Wheeler have effectively swapped roles, so that Dennis is now FASH chairman and Lin is our treasurer. E-mail addresses are unaltered, should you need to contact anyone on the committee. Other committee posts are unchanged except that we welcome Bob Askew onto the team.

As this is the September issue, it is the time for me to make my annual appeal for people to come and try Morris dancing (or any of the other display dance styles in our area). Most sides will be restarting practice this month or next, and if you would like to try, and see whether it is for you, go along to your local team on their practice evening – they may even have a 'taster' session planned in their diary. Wear sensible shoes – trainers are ideal for Morris dancing – and go along give it a try!

Also a reminder that the next FASH workshop is in October, on 14th. Lisa Purkiss will be calling at Twyford Parish Hall to music from Andrew Purkiss. The workshop is titled "Dances Old and New".

Note too, that the first Twyford Ceilidh is at the end of *this* month, not the beginning of next, due to Hall availability.

We are sad to have to report that Sydney Wilkins passed away on Sunday 8th July at Southampton General Hospital. He went into hospital the previous Thursday for a relatively minor

procedure; however, on Saturday his pulse and blood pressure dropped but this was stabilised. Saturday evening Syd was doing the Telegraph crossword but passed peacefully in his sleep early Sunday morning.

Many of you will know Syd from his long association with FASH as its treasurer, and before that as treasurer for the South Hants branch of EFDSS. He, his wife Joyce and Joy Simmons started the Eastleigh Folk Dance Club in 1975 and Joyce was the treasurer for the first few years until Syd took over and remained in that post until early 2014. Syd enjoyed calling on club evenings and particularly liked the dances and music of the Playford era, some of which was played at his funeral.

Syd and Joyce ran monthly Saturday dances for a number of years at the Technical College and at Fleming Park in Eastleigh, and they and their three children were regulars at Folk Camps, so much so that Syd became a Folk Camp Warden.

For FASH, and before that for the South Hants District of EFDSS, Syd was a reliable and conscientious treasurer and a thoughtful and enthusiastic contributor to discussions at committee meetings. Using his experience in printing he was an enormous help in getting our FASH publicity materials looking more streamlined and 'professional'.

Syd retired from the FASH committee in 2011 but he was always available for questions and carried on with distributing his share of Solent Waves for a number of years. Although we haven't seen much of him in more recent years, as he became a bit frailer, we in FASH will always remember his many and varied contributions to folk activities over the years and he will continue to be so remembered by all his friends and colleagues in the folk world.

Joyce and the family would like to thank all of you who attended the funeral and sent cards; this was very much appreciated.
