FASH Chat – American Square Dancing in Southampton

I have been American square dancing more years than most, so it was suggested that I write something down about the ‘early’ days.

I came to Southampton in 1958 and wrote to the local secretary of EFDSS, in the hope that there was some folk dancing in the area, but was in fact recruited into American square dancing meanwhile by colleagues at the laboratory where I worked.

In those days there were no such things as levels or programmes – it was all just square dancing. Many of the halls used were not licensed for public entertainment so all dancers had in theory to be members of a club, but any club in the British Association of American Square Dance Clubs would do.

I have been asked to describe briefly what a typical square dancer looked like in the ‘early’ days! Men wore dark trousers and a fancy shirt, with a neckerchief. Women wore a blouse and a full skirt or dress with petticoats, and often a straight cut underskirt – so as not to show too much when twirling! Many of the clothes were homemade. If the lady’s skirt and the man’s shirt were made of the same material, one understood the two to be engaged or married.

I danced with the Sunny Hills Square Dance Club at a hall in Paynes Road near Foyes Corner. Colin Walton founded the club (of whom more later) and called there. I was made to understand that this was “proper American Square Dancing and not the so-called American square dancing favoured by some folk and ballroom dancers”!

American square dancing at ‘Mayes Department Store’ had been running since the early fifties but was fading out by 1958. The ‘Bournemouth Pioneers Club’, ‘Solent Squares’ and ‘Lazy River’ in Kent had recently started out. There were also square dance clubs in London and in the Nottingham area, but not much in the rest of the county, so we had to travel far and wide for our Saturday dances!

The ‘Sunny Hills Club’ organised three wonderful dance weekends in Beaulieu, where we hired the ‘Domus Room’. Colin Walton had left the Club for the bright lights of London but came back to call for these weekends. He then emigrated to Florida and continued to call there for many years. With Colin gone, club dancers had to step up to the microphone. Jerry Plummer went on to found ‘Silver Spurs’ and Cyril Rendell, the ‘Swaying Eights’. Joe Glendal, John Franklin and Connie Mogridge called for the club until Keith Lovegrove took over, re-forming the club as ‘Bar Kell Squares’.

When I came back from Vietnam in early 1971, ‘levels’ had started to come in. The levels or programmes are: Basic, Mainstream, Plus, Advanced 1 and 2 and the Challenge Levels 1 to 4. If you can dance up to say A2, you can go to any A2, or lower level dance or club in the world and be welcomed. Indeed, I did just that in Vietnam!

Square dancing style has also changed from the ‘high allemande’ hold to elbow height. Interestingly, current Challenge level square

dancers have further lowered the hold to hip level. I am glad to say we still dance the elbow height forearm grip at Alamo Workshop.

At Alamo (7.30 pm on Wednesdays at St. Peter's Church Hall, Bishops Waltham, SO32 1EE, contact: alamoworkshop@gmail.com), Stephen Moore calls Basic, Mainstream and a little Plus. Folk dancers who dance with us find that they

already know nearly all the Basic programme and pick up the Mainstream moves quickly. All square dance moves can be looked up by visiting 'Taminations' on the website www.tamtwirlers.org/taminations.

What with square dancing and achieving professional qualification, I had little time for folk dancing until now! *Martin Slater*
