FASH 'Chat' – Our Winter/Spring Workshops

As I write this, we have recently had our first face to face dance workshop and we are looking forward to the November one, and of course to our Do Something Different day on the 12th December, which will be Maypole dancing in the morning and Longsword in the afternoon, at a new venue for FASH, Durley Memorial Hall SO32 2AD. Come along and have some fun with us!

We will start 2022 with a workshop at Soberton on the 9th January with dances from 'The Cook and the Waitress' by Julian Hill of Sheffield. These will be called by Fiona Birchall with music from Pete & Sue Hall. Fiona writes some lovely dances herself and if she is introducing Julian Hill's dances to us, they must be worth trying, and Fiona's calling combined with Pete and Sue's music will make for an enjoyable day.

On the 6th February we will be at Twyford with Barrie Bullimore and Pete & Sue Hall and 'Contras and Squares – Not for the Faint Hearted!' This doesn't mean that the dances will be impossibly difficult but they might have unusual formations and won't be the sort of dances you might meet at a Saturday dance. Be prepared to be challenged and to have fun, and come with the confidence that 'YOU CAN DO IT'.

Next up, on the 27th February at Soberton, will be our annual West Gallery Music workshop with The Madding Crowd. You can play with

the band or join in the singing, which is in four part harmony, or just come to listen. Music will be provided or you can learn your part by ear. Madeleine Smith with Pete & Sue Hall will be at Soberton the 13th March for 'Dancing Made Visible', including dances from 1650 to the present day. Madeleine will show how the melody and rhythm are an integral part of the dance performance and choreography, covering different dance rhythms and techniques for dancing, and the subtle art of phrasing the dance figures to the melody.

Our final dance workshop of the season will be at Soberton with Ted Morse and Orion's Ring on the 24th April. The workshop is called 'Only Connect' and Ted will have a selection of interesting, fun and challenging dances from near and far, based around four themes. The themes will be muddled up and at the end of the day you will be invited to group the dances and suggest the 'connections'. Ted always provides a day with great dances and some good fun.

We do hope to see you at our workshops and in the meantime, we wish you all a happy and healthy Christmas holiday season.

good enough, and that would be a great shame. Bournemouth Folk Dance Club lost their website when their hosting company closed earlier in the year. They now have a completely new website up and running, details in the dance diary. Regulars will know what the “Posh Frocks” evening means; this dance in January will in much more formal dress, in remembrance of Peggy Samuel and all she did for the club.

Their webmaster reminded me that there are several folk dance clubs just over the border into Dorset which have also restarted after the extended break due to Covid-19. He mentioned Wareham Folk Dance Club (contact details on Bournemouth FDC’s website) which has mostly live music with Rosemary and Steve Hunt. Also run by Rosemary Hunt is the monthly Woodlands Dance Workshop at the Village Hall just west of Verwood. Again see Bournemouth’s website.

Looking outside our county borders in the other direction, and especially for lovers of contra dance, Ashford Folk Dance Club’s Contra Series is running again at Englefield Green, Egham. This month Rhodri Davies is calling to music from The English Contra Dance Band; they have yet to

publish which callers they have in the New Year. Their website is www.ashfordfolk dancers.org.uk.

I understand that 'Set and Turn Single', the journal that used to be the national events diary and directory for the folk dance world, and that went entirely on-line around 2016, is no longer accepting new events; there are no listings since 2019. I have heard that the events diary function has been passed to EFDSS, but if so, there is no obvious events listing on their website other than those taking place at Cecil Sharp House or on-line. I do hope this valuable function has not been lost as it is such a good way of advertising clubs and events widely at minimal cost.

Some of you may know Tom Gregory, a director of FolkActive who worked with FASH in leading the Children's Ceilidhs when FolkActive took over most of the running of them. Now, inspired by the FASH workshop "Winter Songs and Traditions" with Ramskyte in 2019, Tom has assembled a band with several well-known local folk musicians to record a new CD, 'Rejoicéd Much'. The launch concert is at Hanger Farm Arts Centre, where the CD was recorded, on the 2nd December. More details in the advert on page 6.

Belshazzar's Feast are starting their Christmas Tour ('Mistletoe and Whine') at the end of the month, this time we are pleased to say, not via 'Zoom' (except for one concert on the 6th December). The nearest concert to us is the last, on the 23rd December at Whitchurch Folk Club; see the diary entry, above, for ticket purchase details.

Forest Folk's advertisement on page 6 only mentions the February concert (note that it is at the end of the month, not the third Monday) as they are in the comfortable position of having sold out of tickets for this month's The Young'uns concert and have very few tickets left for Steve Knightley in January. Other clubs and arts centres are also reporting good attendances, so it is to be hoped that the few folk clubs which are still closed will soon be able to reopen.

I gather from one of the organisers of Wimborne Minster Folk Festival that several of the area's display sides have closed/folded which is depressing news, although he did say that one of the sides has since "unfolded" – an unusual use of the term.

After a complete "non-event" summer in 2020, and very few festivals able to take place this year, the Wimborne Minster Festival is one of the many

folk festivals around the country whose organisers are getting in early. Although no programme is published yet, 'Earlybird' tickets for the Wimborne Festival are on offer at £65 until the 1st February.

More locally, Wickham Festival has already sold out of its 'Tier 1' tickets; 'Tier 2' tickets are now selling, still offering a reduction on the full price. Interestingly, also on offer are electrical hook-ups for campers and caravanners who really need the luxury, (is this a first for a folk festival?) but they are relatively expensive.

The New Forest Folk Festival has tickets available with a special offer until the end of December: adult 5-day ticket, including camping, for £105.

A little further west, all Purbeck Valley Folk Festival's 'Superearlybird' tickets have gone and 'Earlybird' tickets are now on sale at £135 plus booking fee. No information yet on the guest artists.

The Chippenham Folk Festival is only three days this year instead of the usual four due to the moving of the May bank holiday in connection with the Queen's Jubilee Celebrations. It is attended by many people from our area, and tickets are already available at the 'Earlybird' rate of just over £100, camping extra. They are beginning to list guest artists and acts, but there is no published programme yet.

Looking outside our usual clubs and centres list, Portsmouth's Wedgewood Rooms has Seth Lakeman in concert on the 9th December. Special guest that evening will be Joe Francis. Later on, in February, on the 22nd, Beans on Toast (Jay McAllister) will be there, together with guest Kitty Liv, supporting his new album, 'Survival of the Friendliest', due for release on December 1st.
