FASH 'Chat' - Friends of English Dance

For those of us who know and love English country dance, with its flowing patterns, uplifting music, and warm sense of community, it's hard to understand why more people haven't experienced it. These dances have brought people together for centuries, and they're still alive today in village halls and city venues up and down the country. But we believe this tradition deserves a brighter spotlight and a wider audience.

Friends of English Dance (FED) has been reinvented to do exactly that. We're focused on supporting, promoting, and growing participation in English social dance across the UK.

FED is a volunteer-run organisation with a dedicated committee located around the country, led by Chair Bernie Culkin (Cheshire), Treasurer Louise Siddons (Hampshire), Secretary Mollie Koenigsberger (London), and members Liam Binley (Rutland), Malcolm Sturgess (Berkshire), and Alain Williams (Hertfordshire).

Our first step is to galvanise the community we already have. Across the UK, there are passionate dancers, skilled callers, talented musicians, and tireless organisers keeping our tradition alive. FED is here to connect them — and help their work reach a wider audience.

We have a website, www.friendsofenglishdance.org.uk/, designed to be a central hub for dancers, clubs, bands, and callers. If you're already part of this vibrant world, or if you're just getting started, there's something here for you.

One of the key ways we're helping people connect is through our Club Directory. This is a

tool to help new dancers find a place to join in but we need your help to make it useful (if you remember Set and Turn Single, you know we have BIG shoes to fill!). If you run a club, please add your details to the directory. It's a quick and easy way to help others find their way onto your dance floor.

We've also created directories for bands and callers, vital parts of any dance event. If you're a musician or a caller, we invite you to add your details so organisers and clubs can find you. Let's make it easier to build great events and support our creative community.

Our community Events Calendar is a great way to get the word out and attract new dancers! We encourage everyone to send us their dance details so we can add them to the calendar. These events also feed into our monthly newsletter, which features a roundup of dances happening in the next two months. You can sign up for the newsletter at www.friendsofenglishdance.org.uk/contact to stay informed and inspired.

FED doesn't just promote events — we organise them too. So far, we've had a fantastic afternoon in Surrey with Brooke Friendly and Box of Frogs, and we're thrilled to announce two more events:

- 10th August in Rutland A day of dance with UK callers Liam Binley and Bernie Culkin, and live music by visiting American musicians Audrey Jaber and Alex Cummings.
- 26th October in the North West A dance with American caller Jenna Simpson. Musicians will be confirmed shortly.

To support our work, we invite you to

become a member. It's just £10 per year, and every membership helps us do more from running events to promoting English social dance nationwide.



I had thought the Guildford Music Institute might have held a Come All Ye Open Stage in July, but apparently the June evening was the last one for the present. They have not yet announced a date for their first one in the autumn.

Chichester Folk Song Club's guest for July is Brian Peters, taking the stage there on the 28th. No details yet of guests in the months to come, but of course they meet every week, and even on guest nights, there is still an informal music session for half an hour before the evening proper starts at 8.15.

The folk festival season is well under way; Lichfield Folk Dance Festival is/was near the end of June, which is why this issue of 'Solent Waves' is reaching you slightly earlier than usual – we are heading in that direction and if we waited until we returned, your journal would be rather late.

Lots more festivals still to go: on page 7 there is an advertisement for the Wickham Festival at the very end of the month; before that the New Forest Folk Festival takes place right at the beginning of the month. Even at this late stage, full weekend tickets are still available for the NFFF, although day tickets are no longer on sale. The full range of tickets are still available for the Wickham Festival and the full weekend tickets are still not at the full price, so you can still save £20 per adult by ordering soon.

Warwick Folk Festival is between these two, and slightly overlapping the Wickham Festival is Sidmouth's Folk Week. Purbeck Valley Folk Festival is in the middle of August, then right at the end on the same days are Lyme Folk Weekend and the Wallingford Bunkfest.

We try to keep track of the more local festivals on web our page (www.fash.org.uk/festivals.htm), with details of what tickets are available and whether programmes of events have been published. As each festival date passes we hide the entry on the page, until we have the dates for the following year, when we add them back in.

While there are new folk festivals starting up (for example the Litchfield one and the one day event in Salisbury), it is disappointing to hear that some will not take place again – Tenterden is an example for which the last one was in October. It seems that in at least some cases there is limited financial gain in running small festivals and the organisers have called it a day. Sometimes it is the lack of sponsors which prompts closure. Towersey Festival has gone – let's hope no more of our more local festivals close their doors.

No 'Solent Waves' for August, of course; the

editor and his proof reader are allowed to have July off. Any copy, adverts or anything else publishable, please let me have them by the middle of August for the September issue.

My apologies if you are in the habit of printing 'Solent Waves' off -I am afraid that this is another "11-pager", which means that even if you print it in booklet form you will have a blank page.
